Arrow sat on his Mommy's bed with his leash and harness in his mouth. Mommy took a look at him and laughed.

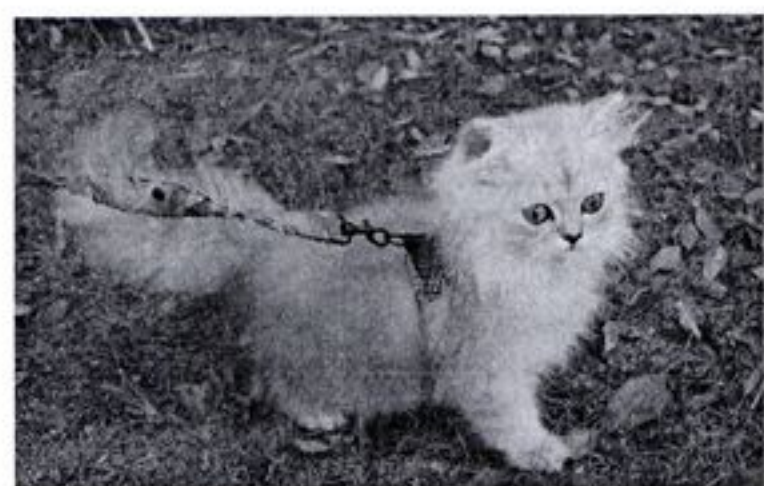
"Arrow," said Mommy. "If you think I am taking you outside at 6 a.m in the morning, you are silly."
